Zagreb County implements national policies and regulations to prevent the unethical sale or promotion of cultural artifacts. Clear rules prohibit illegal trade and export of cultural goods, with oversight carried out by competent authorities and heritage protection agencies.

Cultural heritage is safeguarded through systematic monitoring and licensing of galleries, antique shops, and auction houses, ensuring that artifacts are authentic and legally acquired. Customs and border control agencies further protect heritage by preventing illegal import and export, often in cooperation with international organizations.

Education and public awareness play a key role. Through exhibitions, events, and informational campaigns, citizens and tourists learn about the importance of preserving cultural heritage and are encouraged to act responsibly toward cultural assets.
