



VISITOR CODE OF CONDUCT:
Discover the beauty of the "Green Ring" responsibly

Welcome to Zagreb County! In order to preserve our nature, tradition and hospitality for future generations, we invite you to follow this simple code of conduct during your stay. Become a part of our story in a sustainable way.

1. Respect and protect nature

Our nature parks, forests and rivers are home to many plant and animal species.

- Leave no trace: Take everything you bring with you into nature (packaging, tissues, food scraps), back and dispose of it in the appropriate waste containers.
- Stay on the trails: Use marked hiking and cycling trails to prevent destruction of vegetation and disturbance of wildlife.
- Silence is golden: Enjoy the sounds of nature. Loud music and noise scare animals and spoil the experience for other visitors

2. Support the local community and economy

Your stay directly helps our family farms and artisans.

- Shop local: Choose authentic products like Samobor crystal, licitar, cheese and cream, or top-quality wines from our wine roads.
- Taste local: Visit our family farms. By choosing seasonal food grown in our neighborhood, you reduce your carbon footprint and support local farmers.
- Appreciate tradition: Respect local customs, events, and sacred heritage. Bring memories, not objects of historical significance.

3. Waste is not a fashion accessory

Proper waste disposal is essential for the cleanliness of our waters and forests.

- Recycle: Wherever possible, separate paper, plastic and glass.
- Reduce plastic: Consider using reusable water bottles. The water in our county is of excellent quality and safe to drink.
- Cigarette butts: Never throw cigarette butts into nature – they are dangerous for the environment and can cause fires.

4. Travel smart and safe

- Choose eco-friendly transportation: Wherever possible, explore the county by bike, on foot or by public transportation.
- Fire is dangerous: Only light fires in designated and strictly marked areas, and with maximum caution.
- Respect private property: Many vineyards and fields are privately owned. Enjoy the view, but do not enter without permission.
